


Helen and Wit Boondeekhun

Dear Friends

Thank you so much for your prayers and support throughout the past twelve months. We have seen many answers to prayer in what has been a difficult but fruitful year. We have been especially encouraged by the verse from Galatians 6:9 'Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up'.

Since we last wrote the local school has re-opened and Helen has resumed her volunteer teaching there, to a very enthusiastic Year 9 class. Football training has also begun again with a mix of both old and new players. Some of the boys have started coming along on a Sunday morning which is great to see.

Our youth group is steadily growing, and we now have about 8 or 9 teenagers at various stages in their Christian journey. Most of them are learning to play an instrument: guitar, bass or drums, so we have a worship band emerging. Bam (15) is growing in confidence as a worship leader, and she is also a mentor to several of the other teenage girls. Our adult believers are all maturing in faith and unity, and they are no longer afraid to acknowledge to friends and family that they are followers of Jesus.

Wit and Fluk continue in visiting, helping and praying for many folk in the village. Several people have already prayed to accept Christ but haven't yet taken the next steps in their faith walk. Please pray for them to be able to overcome whatever is holding them back.



We're both relatively well, although Wit still suffers from sleep apnoea and rarely gets a good night's sleep. We are looking forward to a couple of nights away in the mountains for New Year, after the busyness of putting on our Christmas outreach show.

There are some big changes coming up for us next year as we are planning to begin a new venture in another local village. At the moment we are not really sure where that will be, so we would appreciate prayer for God's wisdom and guidance.



We would like to introduce you to Ajarn Moses and Ajarn Mary and their two little girls, Moriyah and Moladah. They will be joining our team next month with the aim of gradually taking over the leadership of the church in Wang Daeng. They are both Bible college graduates with a heart to serve God in rural Thailand, and are also on board with the concept of a holistic approach to church planting. We praise God for His answer to prayer and believe that God will use them both to further establish the congregation here in Wang Daeng.



Pray for Moses, Mary and family as they settle in to life and ministry in Wang Daeng. Pray for God's guidance as we seek Him for our future location.

Pray for our believers to continue to grow in faith and love. Pray that they would be bold to share their faith in Christ Jesus with their friends and families. Pray for more local people to become disciples of Jesus.
